KEY POINTS

-VE Two Thirds of adults in North East Lincolnshire are overweight or obese.

+VE North East Lincolnshire has the 7th lowest proportion of adults with excess weight in the Yorkshire and Humber.

DESCRIPTION

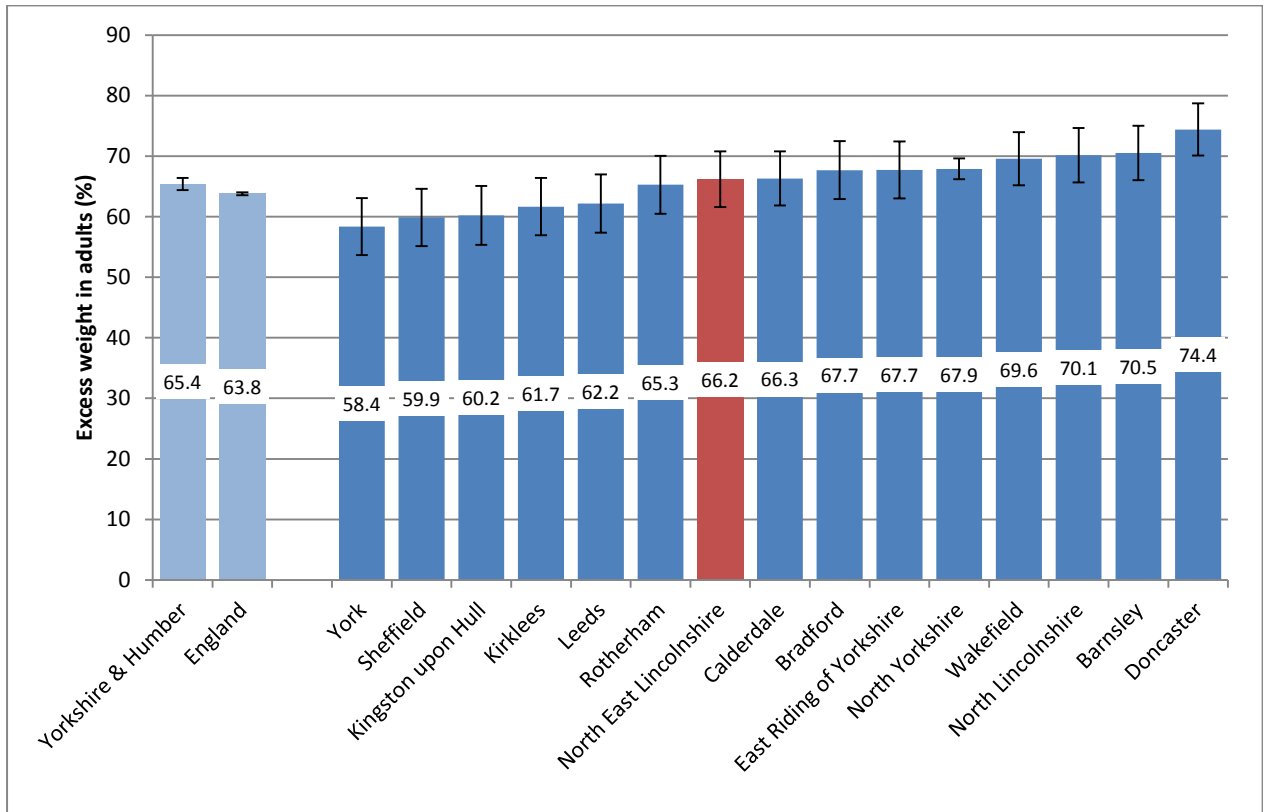
Obesity is a priority area for Government. The Government's "Call to Action" on obesity (published Oct 2011) included national ambitions relating to excess weight in adults, which is recognised as a major determinant of premature mortality and avoidable ill health.

NATIONAL, REGIONAL OR PEER GROUP

Two thirds of adults (66.2%) in North East Lincolnshire are overweight or obese, higher than the regional average of 65.4% and the national average of 63.8%, although not statistically significantly higher. North East Lincolnshire ranks 7th lowest, about half way out of the 15 local authorities in the Yorkshire and Humber region.
