DESCRIPTION

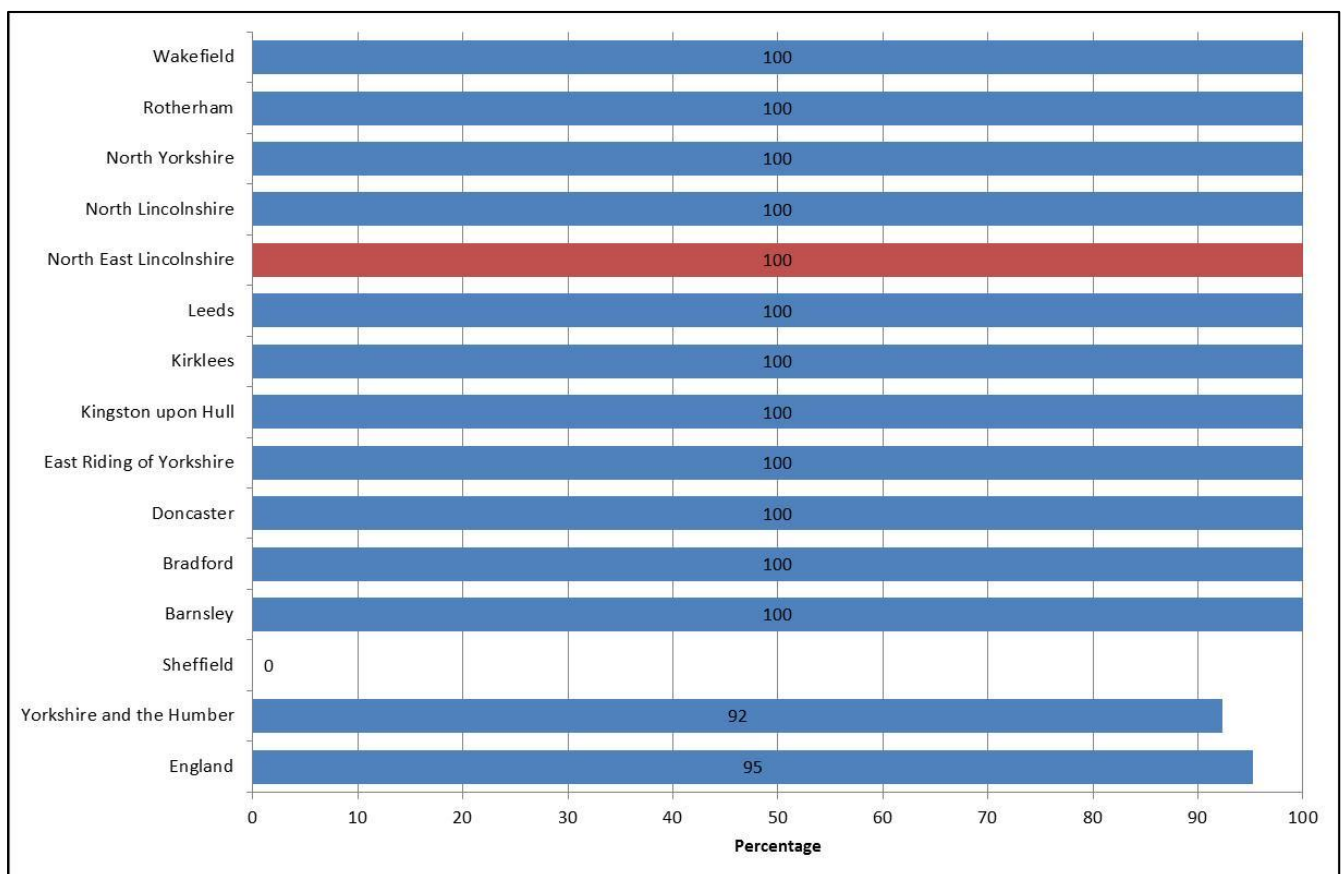
This indicator provides an indication of the preparedness for organisations to respond to health protection incidents and emergencies. A letter was sent out by Public Health England to all Directors of Public Health in England asking the question "Are there clear and appropriate health protection arrangements in place in your local authority?", and the responses form the basis of this indicator. (Improving outcomes and supporting transparency - Part 2, Department of Health, 2012).

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NATIONAL, REGIONAL OR PEER GROUP

Figures presented in Figure 1 show that for 2014/15, 95% of local authorities in England had a comprehensive inter-agency plan for responding to public health incidents. In the Yorkshire and the Humber, 12 of the 15 local authorities had a plan (including North East Lincolnshire), 1 local authority did not have a plan, and 2 local authorities did not respond to the survey.
