## KEY POINTS

North East Lincolnshire CCG has a higher dementia diagnosis rate than the England average.

## DESCRIPTION

There is an estimated 650,000 people in England with dementia, a number expected to double in the next 30 years. Dementia accounts for more expenditure than heart disease and cancer combined and costs society around £20bn a year. The inclusion of this indicator will help public health practitioners to recognise the contribution they can make to minimising the effects of dementia or preventing it through promoting better lifestyle and exercise as up to half of dementias have a vascular component. 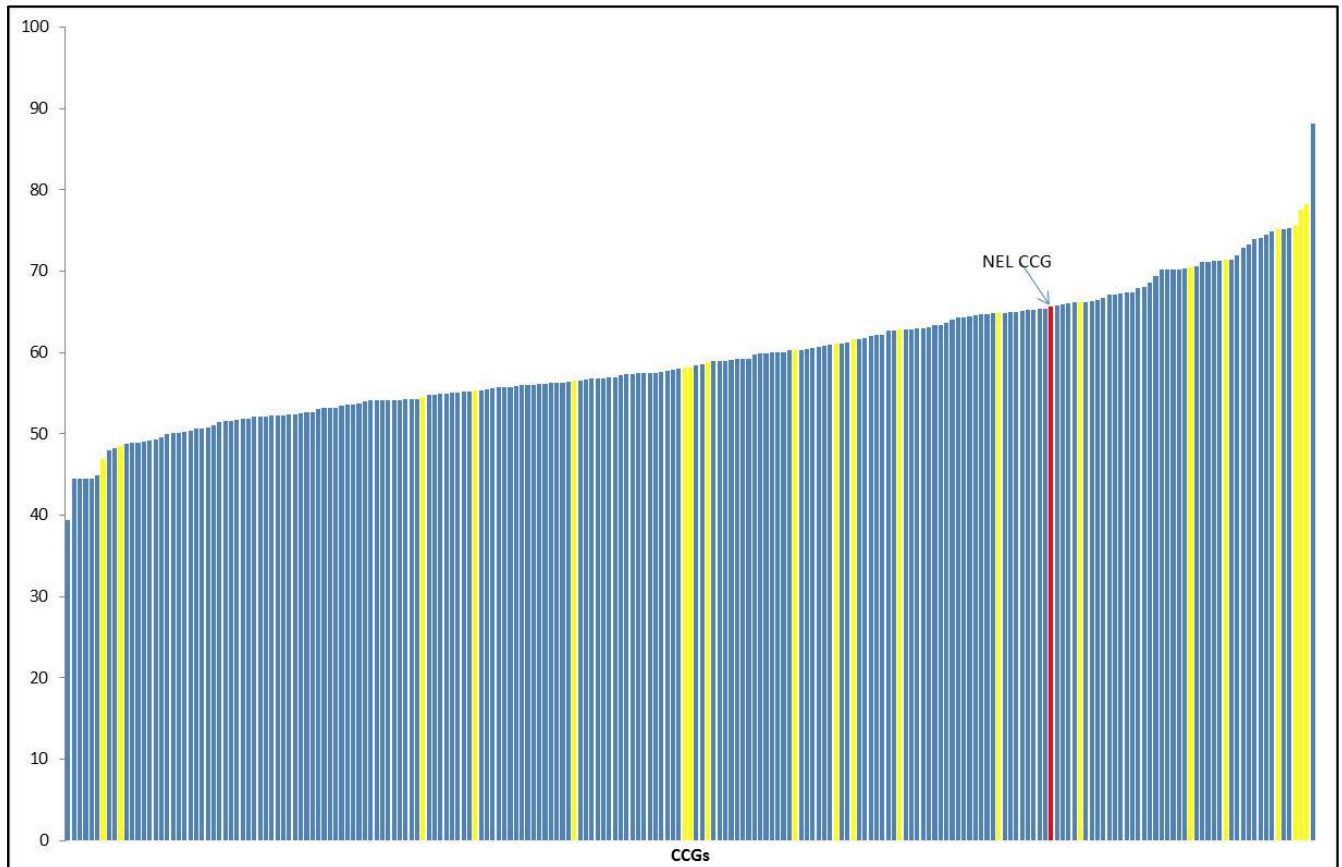
This indicator is defined as the number of people diagnosed with dementia as a percentage of the estimated number of people with dementia.

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## NATIONAL, REGIONAL OR PEER GROUP

Figures for the indicator definition have not been published by PHE, however Figure 1 shows the actual dementia diagnosis rate for North East Lincolnshire CCG, compared to the rates for all CCGs in England. North East Lincolnshire CCG is highlighted in red and statistical peer CCGs are highlighted in yellow.
